Notice of Awards:

Winners will be presented during Award Assemblies at each school in May. Each year funds will be made payable to the student's Catholic high school prior to the start of the school year.

Essay:

No larger than 12 pt. font, double spaced and not to exceed 200 words.

Basis of Selection:

The Selection Committee scores applications based on five categories: School Activities/Leadership; Community Involvement; Academic Performance; Essay; and Financial Need.

Eligibility Requirements: At the beginning of each academic year, recipients will provide the previous year transcripts to the Fidelis Founadation Board for academic review. Recipients must maintain cumulative C average; a minimum of 2.00 GPA or higher at the end of each academic year.
